Mr. Lammey stated that the draft document has been prepared, but that there was still an issue with whether the State Metro Planning funding would be authorized by the Illinois General Assembly. He stated that he needed ideas for projects to fund with the State Metro Planning funding, in case it was awarded. A discussion of potential projects was held, with Mr. Tyson suggesting a downtown parking plan and siting of downtown transfer center. Mr. Tyson moved that the Technical Advisory Committee recommend approval of the draft **FY 2012 Unified Work Program** to the Policy Committee, and Mr. Paukovitz seconded. Unanimous vote.

**CALL TO ORDER**

Chairman Piekarczyk called the meeting to order at 3:00 P.M.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

There was no public comment.

**MINUTES**

Mr. Tyson moved approval of the January 26, 2011 minutes. Mr. McBurney seconded the motion. Unanimous vote.

**AGENDA**

**FY 2011 TIP AMENDMENTS**

Mr. Lammey stated that there were amendments to the IDOT Highway program and to the Local Bicycle and Pedestrian program. Mr. Paukovitz explained that safety funding had become available for a railroad crossing reconstruction at Court Street and the KB&S Railroad. He stated that materials were being purchased with the safety money, and that the Railroad was furnishing the labor.

Mr. McBurney stated that the Greenways project in Manteno has been changed to be under bid by the end of September, so the schedule has been compressed. Mr. Paukovitz moved that the Technical Advisory Committee recommend approval of the proposed amendments to the **FY**
