### **COMPREHENSIVE ZONING AMENDMENTS**

Mr. Skimerhorn informed the members of the Subcommittee that the next six months will see some comprehensive Zoning Code amendments, and that if any member had specific concerns or suggestions that the please contact the staff on those possible changes.

### **ILLIANA STUDY**

Mr. Lammey stated that one of the two contracts for the Illiana Study was signed on April 11, and that stakeholder meetings were being planned for May. He stated that members would be informed as soon as information was available about those stakeholder meetings. Mr. Paarlberg stated that the sentiments of a meeting in his area of the county recently seemed to be in favor of the Illiana being placed farther north than the Kankakee County line.

### **BROCHURE**

Mr. Lammey stated that the transportation brochure that was produced three years ago will be issued again this summer, and that if members had any ideas on what should be placed in the new brochure, they should let him know.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

Mr. Blanchette asked a question about the status of the wind farm project, and Mr. Skimerhorn replied that he had received a call yesterday, indicating to him that the project is still active. Mr. Paarlberg stated some complaints that he had heard on the code enforcement for the county being “too picky”.

Mr. Jarvis announced that the River Roundtable project is coming to a close, and that much more information will be available in the next 6 weeks, including a website that is now under construction. He stated that a kickoff meeting for the project will be held on June 7, 2011, from 4 PM to 8 PM at the Quality Inn. He distributed brochures for the project that are now available.

**CALL TO ORDER**

Chairman Miller called the meeting to order at 10:30 AM, and thanked Mr. Washington for chairing the March 24 meeting in his absence.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

There was no public comment.

**MINUTES**

Mr. Howell made a motion to accept the Minutes of the March 24, 2011 meeting as presented, seconded by Mr. Washington. Motion passed.

**2010 CENSUS DATA**

Mr. Skimerhorn presented a handout that compared census information from the 2000 census to that of the 2010 census and answered questions. He also presented a website ([k3gis.com/census](http://k3gis.com/census)) that showed population breakouts by various jurisdictions in a graphic format. Mr. Howell asked if the deadline for appeal for census information was June 1, and Mr. Skimerhorn stated that he believed it was.

**ST. ANNE COMMUNITY STUDY**

Mr. Skimerhorn gave a PowerPoint presentation on the St. Anne Study, and copies were distributed to Subcommittee members. Subcommittee members made a number of varied suggestions for similar future studies. Mr. Skimerhorn stated that a final public hearing was held in St. Anne, and that over 100 people attended.

Mr. Skimerhorn stated that the project was now in the hands of St. Anne to proceed, and that County staff was finished with the Study. He confirmed that the study had been done at no cost
