
#### AMENDMENT TO THE FY 2014 UNIFIED WORK PROGRAM

- WHEREAS** the Federal Highway Act of 1962, as amended, and the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended, provides for an urban transportation planning process; and
- WHEREAS** the Kankakee Area Transportation Study (KATS) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Kankakee Urbanized Area, and the Policy Committee has the specific responsibility to direct and administer the continuing urban transportation planning process; and
- WHEREAS** the Unified Work Program (UWP) for the Kankakee Area Transportation Study for FY 2014 was developed in accordance with the State and Federal laws and established local procedures and adopted by the Kankakee Area Transportation Study Policy Committee on May 8, 2013; and
- WHEREAS** the funding amounts for work elements have been revised (as detailed in the attached memo) for the Transportation Planning Work Program. These revisions require an amendment to the **FY 2014 Unified Work Program**; and
- WHEREAS** the Kankakee Area Transportation Study Technical Advisory Committee has reviewed the proposed amendment to the **FY 2014 Unified Work Program**, and recommends approval; **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT**
- RESOLVED** that the Kankakee Area Transportation Study Policy Committee adopts the changes proposed in the attached amendment to the **FY 2014 Unified Work Program**; **AND BE IT FURTHER**
- RESOLVED** that the Kankakee Area Transportation Study staff is instructed to transmit this amendment to the appropriate State and Federal agencies.



SUBJECT: Requested Amendment to **FY 2014 Unified Work Program**

Near the end of every program year, we shift funding around in the Transportation Program budget to reflect budget realities. This year is no different. The proposed amendment to the **FY 2014 Unified Work Program** is revenue neutral, in that the total amount of PL and FTA funding remains the same.

The funding being changed from each work element is shown in the table below:
