

AMENDMENT TO THE FY 2015 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM


- WHEREAS** the Federal Highway Act of 1962, as amended, and the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended, provides for an urban transportation planning process; and
- WHEREAS** the Kankakee Area Transportation Study (KATS) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Kankakee Urbanized Area, and the Policy Committee has the specific responsibility to direct and administer the continuing urban transportation planning process; and
- WHEREAS** the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Kankakee Area Transportation Study for FY 2015 was developed in accordance with the State and Federal laws and established local procedures and adopted by the Kankakee Area Transportation Study Policy Committee on June 25, 2014; and
- WHEREAS** an amendment was made at the August 27, 2014 Policy Committee meeting for the Bourbonnais Parkway (6000 N. Road) project. The request from the Village of Bourbonnais is attached to this Resolution.
- WHEREAS** the changes proposed are documented in the memorandum attached to this Resolution; and
- WHEREAS** the Kankakee Area Transportation Study Technical Advisory Committee has reviewed the proposed amendment to the **FY 2015 Transportation Improvement Program**, and forwards to the Policy Committee for approval; **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT**
- RESOLVED** that the Kankakee Area Transportation Study Policy Committee adopts the changes proposed in the attached amendments to the **FY 2015 Transportation Improvement Program**; **AND BE IT FURTHER**
- RESOLVED** that the Kankakee Area Transportation Study staff is instructed to transmit this amendment to the appropriate State and Federal agencies.

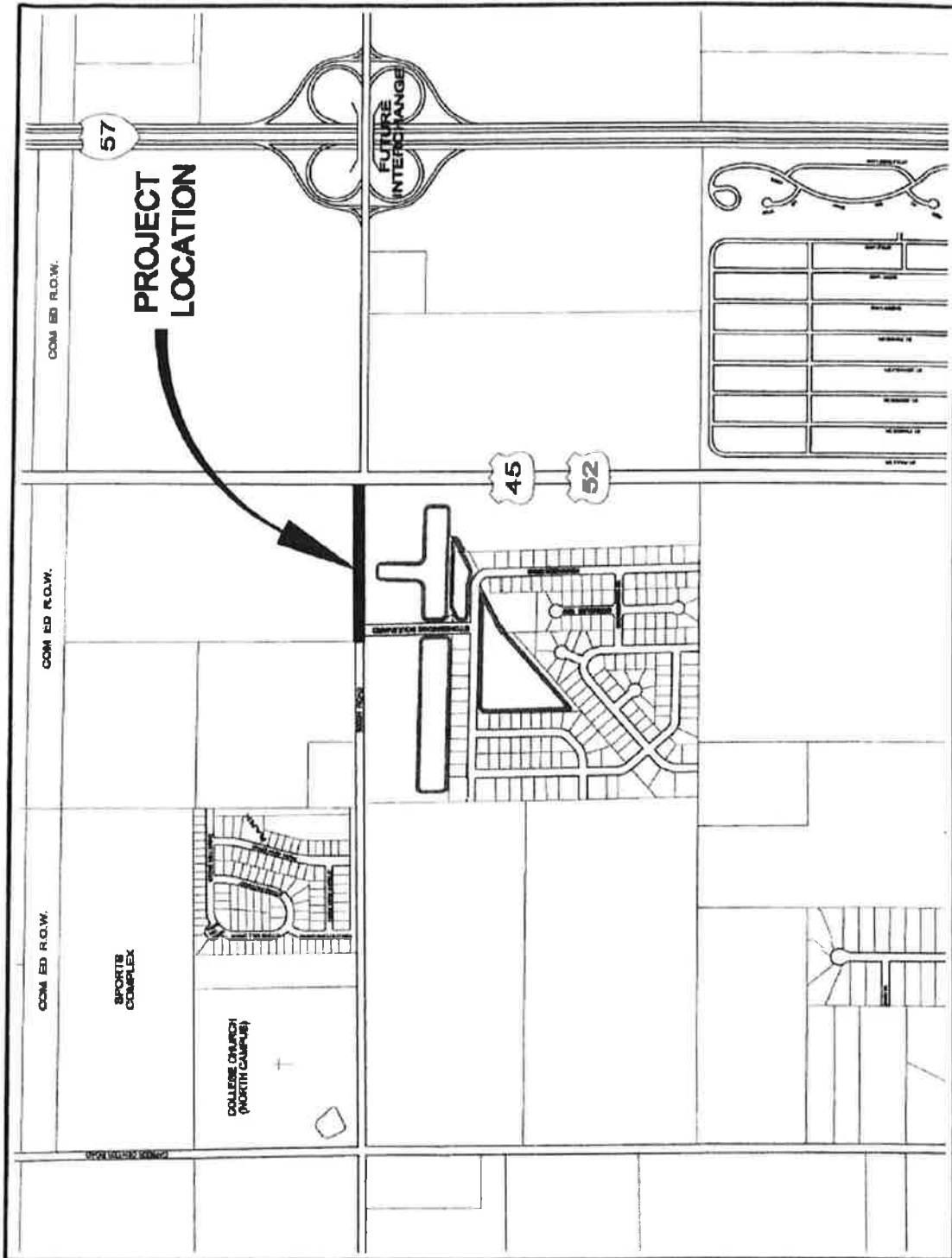
The areas north and south of 6000N Road are predominately residential with commercial at the intersection of US 45/52.

East of US 45/52, an interchange is proposed for Interstate 57 in 2014 that will include reconstructing 6000N to US 45/52.

West of Career Center Road, a future loop south to Illinois Route 102 at Warner Bridge Road is proposed.

The section from Stonebridge Boulevard to Career Center Road will be constructed at a later date with future funding.
