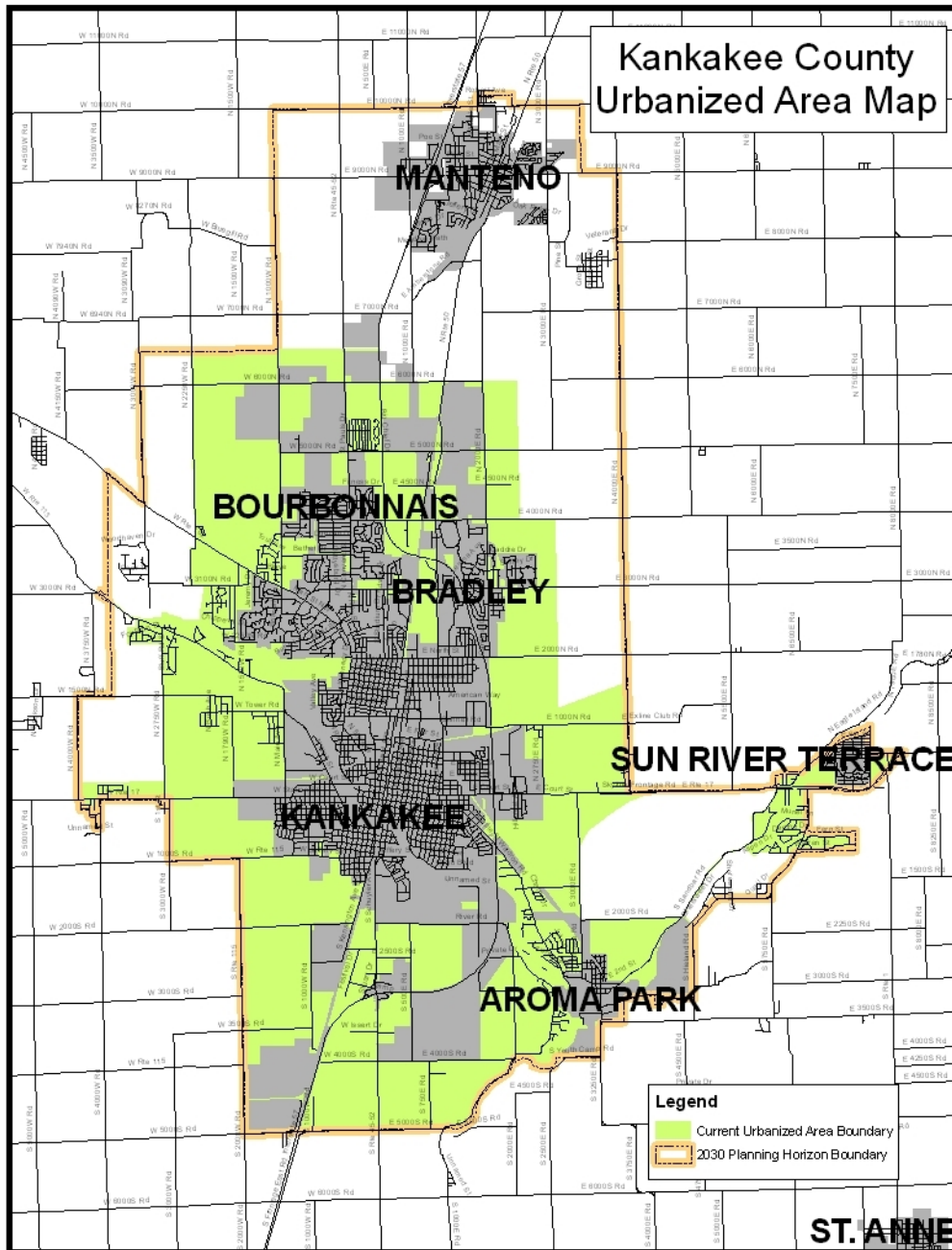

# INTRODUCTION

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, passed by Congress and signed by President Obama in January 2009, allocates federal transportation funding to the Kankakee Urbanized Area. The Kankakee Urbanized Area consists of the Villages of Aroma Park, Bourbonnais, and Bradley, the City of Kankakee, and portions of Kankakee County shown as the green shaded area in the following map:



Funding is allocated in two broad categories of funding, in transit and highway.

## TRANSIT PORTION

Two agencies are requesting American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funding for transit related projects. The agency responsible for urban transit service in the Kankakee Urbanized Area is River Valley METRO Mass Transit District, and they have made requests contained in the first three lines of the following table. The agency responsible for rural transit service in Kankakee County is Kankakee County, and they have made requests contained in the fourth the fifth lines of the following table.

Two agencies are requesting American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funding for highway related projects. The agency responsible for local highway projects in the Kankakee Urbanized Area is the Kankakee Area Transportation Study, comprised of the Villages of Aroma Park, Bourbonnais, and Bradley, the City of Kankakee, the County of Kankakee, and the Illinois Department of Transportation. 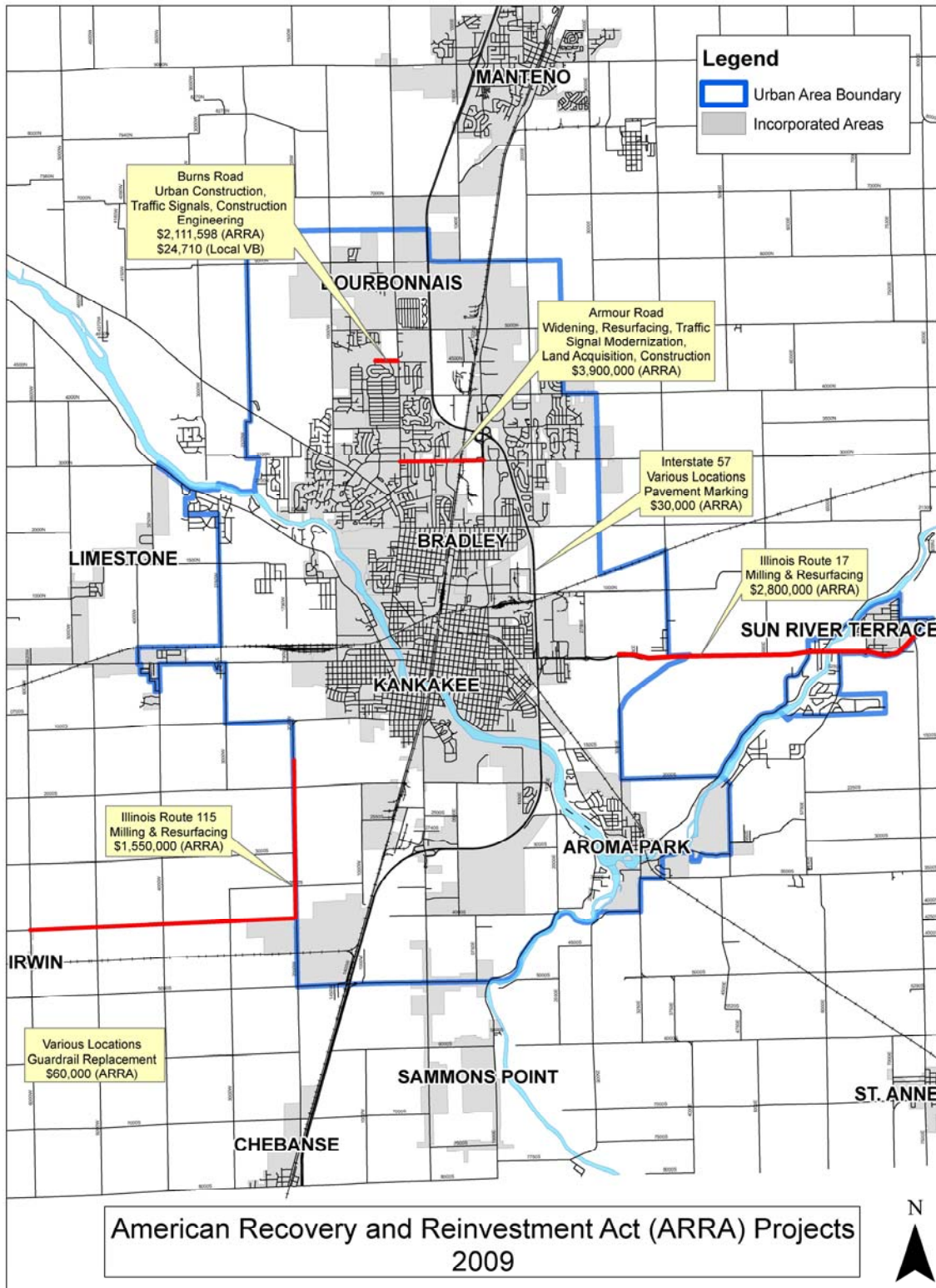
